Dear Friends,

Our team returns to Balfate, Honduras in March 2018 to provide ear, nose and throat care to the indigent population. Hospital Loma de Luz is run by the original founder, Dr. Jeff McKenney. The hospital is funded entirely through donations and is staffed by volunteers that provide primary care and general surgical services to over 900 patients per month.

Dr. Kaalan Johnson established this medical mission trip to Honduras in 2008 and has been back each year since. In addition to Dr. Johnson, this year's team will also include Drs. Isaac Bohannon, Sapna Patel, and Daniel Low; and resident surgeons Angelique Berens, Sebastian Jara, and Sarah Akkina. We are excited to see our prior patients in follow-up and anxious to help the many patients already screened by the primary care team.

Attending physicians will cover their own expenses. However we anticipate a budget shortfall for resident members of our team and other required expenses for necessary equipment and supplies.
